

“Passionately Promoting Art for All”

The Carnegie Visual Arts Center, housed in a preserved and repurposed Carnegie Library building, is located at the intersection of Church Street and Oak Street within the Old Decatur district. Surrounded by a neighborhood of restored historic homes, The Carnegie is within two blocks of the Tennessee River and Rhodes Ferry Park, or Founders Park and Historic Bank Street. Close by is the future Fine Arts College, a partnership between Calhoun Community College and Athens State University.

The Carnegie building was constructed in 1904 with funding from the Carnegie Foundation and housed Decatur’s main library for many years until the library’s needs outgrew the building.

In 1997 city and community leaders formed a public/private partnership and began the renovation of the Carnegie Library into the Carnegie Visual Arts Center. In April, 2003 the arts center opened and began to serve the community. The Carnegie is a approximately 2800 square feet on the main level and 1370 square feet on the lower level. The Carnegie presents multiple exhibitions throughout the year featuring a variety of local, regional, national, and international art through solo and group shows. The main level of the Carnegie is also used for receptions, concerts, facility rentals such as weddings, parties or meetings, and other special events. In the Daikin America Education Center, on the lower level, we offer classes, camps, and workshops for all ages, as well as, small group meeting space.

The Carnegie Visual Arts Center is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization supported through grants along with corporate and private donations.

A large portion of our funding comes from individual, family, and business memberships. We hope you will join the Carnegie Visual Arts Center in our mission to “Passionately promote art for all.”
