



Prince and Princess Parade Information and Registration

The Carnegie Visual Arts Center presents the area's first Mardi-Gras-style celebration. Partnering with other area organizations, we will host the first annual Carnegie Carnival. Promoting art and creativity, family fun, and downtown revitalization, February 17 and 18, 2012 will be two days of celebration with parties and parades. Proceeds will benefit the Carnegie Visual Arts Center and other non-profit organizations in the Decatur area.

The Prince and Princess Parade is for children, and will be held Saturday, February 18, 2012 at 1:00 PM. The parade route will begin on 2nd Avenue at Gordon St. and continue onto Lee Street/Bank Street, ending at Founder's Park near the Old State Bank. The parade will benefit and be run by *Parents and Children Together* of Morgan County.

Group registration is \$25. Registration form and fee must be turned in at the Carnegie Visual Arts Center by Tuesday, February 7, 2012 at 5 PM. Information sheets, with parade line up and parade route map, will be available on February 10, 2012 at 10 AM.

Prince and Princess Parade participants must purchase approved parade "throws" or objects from The Carnegie in advance if desired. Only approved "throws" will be allowed in the parade.
